Dangerous site	Participants Operators Spectators	Falls and slips Moving objects	Equipment must be kept in a designated area which allows for a zone around the equipment. Equipment must be set up following the manufacturer's instructions. Equipment is to be set up on a sound and level area with no objects causing potential for trips during play.	Low	Yes
Users safety	Participants	Too many users Falls and slips Moving objects	The number of users specified by the manufacturer is not to be exceeded. The equipment must be used in accordance with the manufacturer's guidelines. Users must be of an appropriate age and dressed suitably for the equipment. A trained operator will be in control of the equipment at all times who is briefed in <u>safe running of the equipment</u> .	Low	Yes
Unsupervised children	Participants	Accidents	All children to be with a supervising adult.	Low	Yes
